

MATHS – KEY STAGE 4-

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Subject description

- Year 12 are the first year to study the new 2-year A-level Mathematics course.
- The Mathematics course is interesting, challenging and well-respected by universities and employers.
- It covers three main areas of Mathematics: Pure, Mechanics and Statistics and provides an excellent foundation for studying any mathematical or scientific subject beyond A-level.
- Year 13 are the last year to study the AS/A2 Mathematics Course.
- Core 3 and Core 4 modules will build on prior learning in Year 12, and Mechanics 1 will develop students' understanding of the overlap between Mathematics and Physics.
